Dress Code Policy

Old Noarlunga Primary School encourages all students to strive for personal excellence and to take pride in themselves, their school and their community. We promote socially just practices and equity among all students. In support of these aims, we have developed a School Dress Code as a requirement for all students attending Old Noarlunga Primary School. The School Dress Code will support students, teachers and families in the following ways:

- projecting a positive school image whereby all students identify as part of the school
- promoting equality of appearance among students, diffusing a competitive or harassing environment where students may be labelled according to their clothing
- increasing the safety of students through an easy means of identification of students whilst in the care of school, either on school grounds or when taking part in excursions or sporting activities
- ensuring students are suitably dressed for the diversity of learning activities contained within the school day

DRESS CODE COLOURS:

The Old Noarlunga Primary School colours are Navy Blue and White. Tops and headwear are to have no slogans or motifs other than the school logo. The use of the school logo on garments is optional.

ACCEPTABLE CLOTHING STYLES / ACCESSORIES:

- Polo Shirt – school polo with school logo, or plain navy blue or plain white
- Shorts – navy blue plain of appropriate length
- Dress (Summer) - blue and white checked school dress
- School supplied 'skorts'
- Dress (Winter) – blue check school dress
- Windcheater – school jumper with school logo, or plain navy blue
- Vest – navy blue
- Skivvy – plain white or navy
- Leggings – plain navy
- Trousers / pants (including cargo) – plain navy
- Tracksuit pants – plain navy
- School supplied zipped navy and white jacket
- Tights – navy
- Socks – plain colour (navy or white)
- Bike shorts or sports briefs – navy (under school dress only)
- Hat – Broad Brimmed or Legionaries (navy blue)
- Year 7 Seniors Uniform
- Shoes – closed in shoes or sneakers, enclosed sandals can be worn in warmer weather
- Hair ties / accessories – neutral, navy or white in colour
- Plain navy beanie
- Studs (preferred) or sleeper earrings
- Clear nail polish

UNACCEPTABLE CLOTHING STYLE / ACCESSORIES:



- T-shirts or windcheaters with slogans
- Ripped or tattered clothing
- Midriff tops and singlet tops
- Denim jeans and shorts
- Miniskirts and extremely short 'mini' shorts
- Thongs, slippers, crocs, ugg boots and party shoes
- Beanies of any colour besides navy
- Dangling earrings or costume jewellery
- Facial make up
- Facial piercings (besides earlobe piercings) must be covered with band aids for safety reasons

NOTES:

The expectation is that all clothing should be neat and tidy.

Hair below shoulder length is required to be tied back for safety and hygiene reasons.

Please note that all uniform items must be appropriate which means that safety and modesty are paramount.

Shorts must come to at least half way down the thigh. Pants must be at ankle length. Necklines must be modest.

Cancer SA recommends wide brimmed, legionnaire style or buckets hats. Hats with graffiti or hats that are torn or tattered are not acceptable.

Black leather shoes or predominantly white sneakers are the recommended footwear for school. Children are involved in fitness and / or PE lessons most days, play outside at recess and lunch and may require safe footwear for Science, technology and Arts lessons.

OPTIONS FOR PURCHASE:

Parents may purchase the school uniform through the front office during school office hours (8.30am to 3.00pm Monday to Friday), using cash or EFTPOS facilities.

Large department stores stock a large range of navy and white garments which fall within Old Noarlunga Primary School's Dress Code Policy.
